Ordinance #12

Revising and Levying taxes for the year 1956:

Be it hereby enacted and ordained by the Borough of Deer Lake, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, in Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1.

That in accordance with Section 12, P.L. 386 and its amendments of the Borough Code, a tax of fifteen (15) mills on the valuation assessed for county purposes is hereby levied for general borough purposes for the year 1956, on all properties, offices, professions, and persons made payable by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for county rates and levies; that in accordance with said section and amendments, there is levied an additional tax of five (5) mills to pay interest and sinking fund charges on municipal indebtedness, together with any taxes covenanted to be paid thereon. The total taxes levied aforesaid amount to twenty (20) mills.

Enacted into an ordinance and passed by the Council of the Borough of Deer Lake this 10th day of April, 1956.
