Ordinance #17

An Ordinance creating a Department of Borough Planning; providing for a Borough Planning Commission, fixing the number and term of the members of the Commission; prescribing the duties and powers of said Commission.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough Council of the Borough of Deer Lake that:

Section 1.

There is hereby created a Department of Borough Planning consisting of five (5) members who shall be known as the Borough Planning Commission.

Section 2.

Members of the Borough Planning Commission shall be residents of the Borough of Deer Lake, and shall be selected by the Borough Council of the Borough of Deer Lake, to serve for a term of five (5) years, provided however, in the first instance, one member shall be appointed for one (1) year; one member for two (2) years; one member for three (3) years; one member for four (4) years; and one member for five (5) years. Whenever a vacancy shall occur the appointment shall be for the unexpired portion of said term.

Section 3.

The Commission shall annually furnish to Borough Council a report of their transactions during the preceding year.

Section 4.

The Commission shall have the authority to make and alter rules and regulations for its organization and subsequent procedure.

Section 5.

The Borough Planning Commission shall perform all the duties and shall exercise all the powers conferred upon planning commissions by law.

Section 6.

All Ordinances or part of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
