Ordinance #20

An Ordinance laying out, opening, and adopting as a public street in the Borough of Deer Lake, a street to be designated as Ash Road, and fixing and regulating the width thereof.

The Borough of Deer Lake hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1.

The following street, which is hereby designated as Ash Road, is hereby laid out, opened, and ordained as a public street in the Borough of Deer Lake: Beginning in the center of Lake Front Drive, at a point of a distance of Two Hundred Twenty-Five (225) feet from the center of Willow Road and Lake Front Drive on the South, and a distance of Two Hundred Eighty-Five (285) feet from said point on the north, then a general Westerly direction approximately Three Hundred Eighty-Five (385) feet to a point parallel with the Western side of the deer lake Fire House Building.

Section 2.

The said street shall consist of a central roadway for vehicular traffic Sixty (60) feet in width.

Duly presented and ordained and enacted at a special meeting of the Borough of Deer Lake, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania on the 15th day of May, A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty Seven (1967).
