Ordinance #6

An ordinance fixing the license fee to be paid to the Borough of Deer Lake, County of Schuylkill, State of Pennsylvania, for poles located the public streets and alleys of the said Borough.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Deer Lake, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania:

Section 1.

That for all poles used for telegraph, telephone, electric light and power, and other purposes, now erected or hereafter erected on the public streets and alleys of this borough, an annual license fee shall be paid by the several and respective companies, corporations, partnerships, individuals, etc. owning the same, in the manner following, to wit: For every such pole in actual use or not in actual use the sum of twenty-five (\$0.25) cents per annum, to be paid to the Borough Treasurer at the end of each Borough fiscal year.

Section 2.

That the provisions of this ordinance shall go into effect immediately from and after the effective date hereof.

Section 3.

That all ordinances, resolutions, and motions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
