Ordinance #5

An ordinance granting to Pennsylvania Power and Light Company, its successors, assigns, and lessees, permission and consent to construct, operate, and maintain electric lines and appurtenances upon, along, across, over, and under the public roads, streets, highways, and other public ways of the Borough of Deer Lake, County of Schuylkill, State of Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Deer Lake:

Section 1.

That permission and consent be and the same is hereby granted to Pennsylvania Power and Light Company to construct, operate, and maintain electric lines upon, along, across, over, and under the public roads, streets, highways, and other public ways of the Borough of Deer Lake, including such poles, wires, crossarms, insulators, transformers, fixtures, conduits, manholes, cables, and other structures, appliances, and appurtenances as may be from time to time necessary for the proper and convenient transaction of the business of supplying light, heat, and power, or for any of them, by means of electricity to the public.

Section 2.

That said lines shall be constructed and maintained in a workmanlike manner and the said Pennsylvania Power and Light Company shall promptly replace and properly restore any sidewalk or street that may be disturbed in the doing of such work. The location of all poles hereafter erected shall be under the supervision of the Street Committee of the Borough.

Section 3.

That the permission and consent hereby granted shall extend to the said Pennsylvania Power and Light Company, its successors, assigns, and lessees.

Section 4.

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after a certified copy of this ordinance and of the said Pennsylvania Power and Light Company's acceptance hereof are filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

Section 5.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
